**3 Mile Walk -17 and under** – entry is free and includes a participants medal, a beverage, snacks from Farm Boy and a slice of Domino's Pizza after the run!

**All other Events - 18 and over \$45** – includes the **Rotary Brantford Classic Run T-shirt, a participants medal, a beverage, snacks from Farm Boy and a slice of Domino's Pizza after the run!**
